



EXIT EXAM




Exit exam was conducted for the 2020-2021 outgoing batch with the objective to evaluate the essential competencies achieved. The essential competencies (knowledge and skills) required by a novice graduate nurse were identified by the departments. MCQ online test was conducted through Learning Management System (YENGAGE) and the skill is assessed by skill stations (OSCE). Student's interpersonal and technical skills were also assessed. Individual feedback was collected from the students after completion of their examination.

My journey is to find the end of everything That end which could obviously embrace me If I am in need of or it will reach me When it needs me long


Well, U may have heard the dark side of it But just try loving it... That's the belief which gives me the strength whenever I loose
